

SHELTON MEMORIAL PARK

(dba Shelton Cemetery Association)

1. A five character Map Index designation is used to help locate a grave space. It can be found after the name of the interred at the onsite Locator Kiosk Display or through Web Site Access.

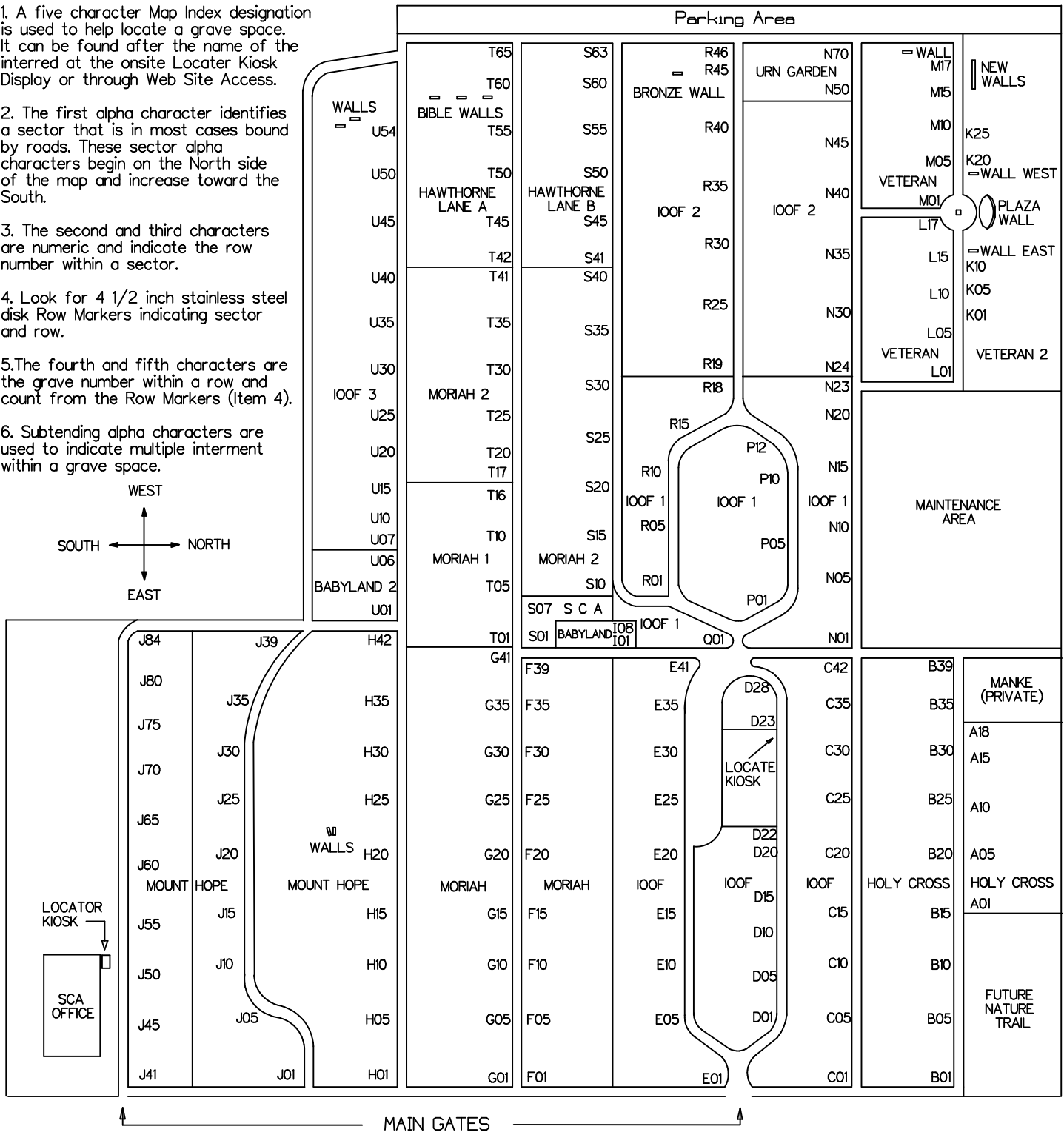
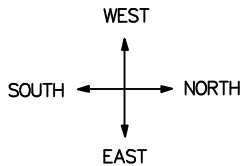
2. The first alpha character identifies a sector that is in most cases bound by roads. These sector alpha characters begin on the North side of the map and increase toward the South.

3. The second and third characters are numeric and indicate the row number within a sector.

4. Look for 4 1/2 inch stainless steel disk Row Markers indicating sector and row.

5. The fourth and fifth characters are the grave number within a row and count from the Row Markers (Item 4).

6. Subtending alpha characters are used to indicate multiple interment within a grave space.
